By signing below, I agree that **I will not**:

- Post negative, threatening, or defamatory comments about MBYFL participants, parents, coaches, officials, or volunteers.
- Share private team, player, or league information publicly.
- Bully, harass, or target any youth athlete, parent, coach, or official online.
- Post or tag images/videos of participants without proper permission.
- Post inflammatory, inappropriate, or offensive content related to MBYFL games, practices, or events.
- Use social media to circumvent league rules or policies.
- Engage in any conduct online that could bring disrepute to MBYFL or its programs.

- Verbal or written warnings from the MBYFL Executive Board/Team.
- Suspension from coaching or league events.
